This small timber framed fibro clad building has a corrugated iron gable roof with a skillion roof to the rear. A domed acrylic skylight has been installed to the main roof (north) below the apex of the gable. A separate verandah roof to the front (north) is supported on painted brick pillars with a painted brick balustrade. Windows are timber framed casement style. boundary.

The cottage originally had a skillion roof and was clad with corrugated iron. (Source: Stan Gratte).

It is believed that this house was built c.1940 by Jack Marsden who was responsible for the construction of many similar houses built for sale to settlers in the Wonthella area. It is thought that the materials were recycled from buildings at the Utakara Showground.
