This stone house has a hipped colorbond roof with a separate hipped roof to the front (east) main room with a lean-to roof over a fibro clad extension to the rear. A bullnose verandah supported on timber posts fronts the south east facade. Stone work to the front facade is coursed and finely pointed with red brick quoining and arches to the openings and matching brick quoining to the comers. To the side the stone work is coursed random rubble with brick quoining to the window opening. Windows are timber framed and double hung and there is a corbelled brick chimney to the south west. There is a low picket fence to the front boundary.


