This stone house has a hipped comugated iron roof punctuated by two tall rendered masonry chimneys to the north and south. There is a lean-to roof to the rear which covers a fibro clad extension. Windows are small paned and casement style to the front facade. A low rendered masonry wall forms the street boundary of the place.
