This painted stone building is set on a comer with entry doors to the comer and west facade. There is a hipped comugated iron roof which is punctuated with a two tall rendered corbelled chimneys. The stone work is coursed and features rendered quoining to the openings with rendering to the walls to half a metre above ground level. Windows are a mixture of timber framed double hung with a large fixed six pane shop window to the west facade. The building has been renovated for use as a residence, with a separate garage/store constructed to the rear comer of the site
