This rendered brick house has a tiled hipped roof with separate gables to the main front room and to the rear. The painted walls to the front have plain render to the lower two-thirds with stucco above, to the sides the lower two-thirds is painted brick with stucco above. The hipped roof extends to cover the front verandah which is supported on half decorative concrete posts set on masonry pillars with a masonry balustrade between them. The front gable end has a circular timber vent. Below the vent there are three windows to the main room above which is a tiled awning supported by timber braces. A tall chimney punctuates the tiled roof. Constrction materials of the front fence, being large limestone blocks with pool fence infill panels, is not in keeping with the style of the house.

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
