This timber framed weatherboard clad house has a tiled gable roof with a separate gable roof to the front (main) room. The roof extends to cover the verandah which is supported on timber posts with decorative braces to the verandah beam. The gable ends have fibro and timber batten infill with consoles to the eaves. Windows below the gables feature a tiled awning and are timber framed casement style. There is a brick extension with a skillion roof to the rear and a windmill in the rear yard.

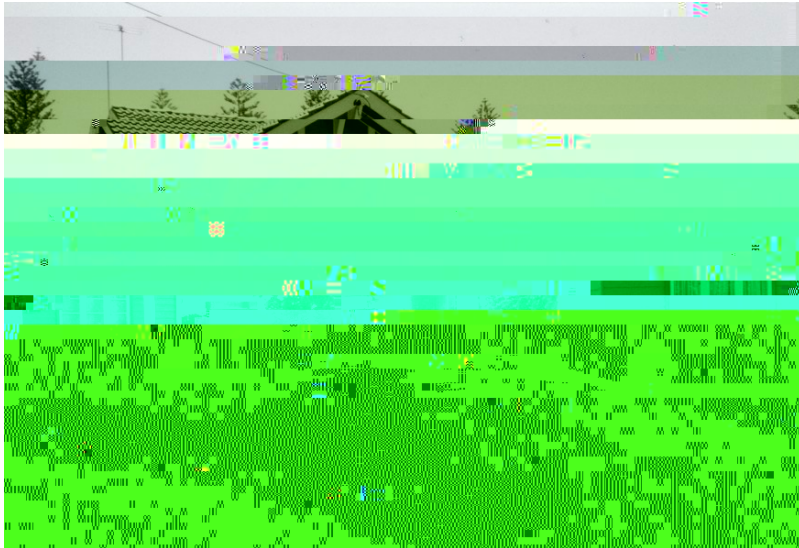
