This small rendered stone house has a steeply pitched hipped comugated iron roof with a broken back extension which covers the front verandah and side, used as garage. The verandahs are supported on timber posts with a fibro balustrade. There is a lean-to roof to the rear and windows are timber framed and casement style.
