Materials for the lighthouse arrived on board 'Lady Louise' from England in June 1877. A newspaper article of the time stated the lighthouse "when erected will be the best light on the Australian Coast." The foundation of the lighthouse was laid on 1 August 1877 however it was later taken up as it was orientated incorrectly. A newspaper article of 19 November, 1877, reveals that Mr Stokes from England relaid the foundation and commenced erection of the cast iron tower. (Sources: Australian Maritime
