Located on the north west comer of the intersection of Kennedy and Georgina Roads, this simple stone building has a comugated iron gable roof. The place has brick quoining to the windows and brick buttresses. A metal awning is attached over the twin windows to the east elevation with three airvents to the gable end. There is a corbelled brick chimney to the south and a carport attached to the west side. A large brick extension has been added to the north elevation while a fibro and comugated iron clad extension is located to the south facade, both to facilitate the use of the place as a residence.

In 1912, 4 acres of land owned by Mr George Hamersley was resumed for the Georgina School. The school was built to service the educational needs of local children. Since its closure, the building has been extended and adapted for use as a residence by Mrs Criddle who has lived in the fomerschool since c 1980.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The former Georgina State School has considerable historic and social significance for its association with education in the Greenough district for many years. Although altered, the original structure is characteristic of rural schools, it being small in scale and simple in style. The significance of the former school is enhanced by its close proximity to the former Georgina Methodist Chapel.
