This house is of brick construction with a comugated iron gable roof which extends over verandahs to the north and west. Masonry columns support twin timber verandah posts with brick balustrade infill. The place features concrete lintels to openings, coloured glass to windows and fibro infill to window.

2004/5 Review: The house has been reroofed. To the south of the house is a large timber framed, comugated iron clad workshop with large opening onto Padbury Road.
