

bcated on the west bank of the Greenough River, McCartney Cottage consists of the original liestone structure which has been added to with red stone to for an 'L'. The lace has a hin ped corrugated iron roo f which is practuated by a tall brick corbelled chieney. There is a lean-to moo fto the rear which is enclosed with for sheeting. In recent ties a brick addition has provided a large living area, while there is a sall concrete block extension to the south. Pergola has been added to the west and a car part is attached to the north elevation.
