

Located at the westem entrance into Pindar and fronting the north side of Sharpe Street, the Pindar Garage is of timber framed construction and clad with corrugated iron sheeting. The central portion running northsouth has a high curved roof with low pitched skillion roofs on either side. At both ends is a pair of ledge and braced doors. The front (south) facade also features two small paned timber windows and a ledge, braced and boarded door which leads into the fmr office on the eastem business based in Pindar to compete with the camel teams, Harold James 'Jim' Wright and George Edward Stoner formed a partnership and commenced trading as Stoner & Wright, Motor Engineers and Haulage
