

Construction of the Rectory was financed using money raised from the sale of land bequeathed to the parish by Mr David Warren. Late in September 1927, the 'Mullewa Mail' reported that: "the new rectory is now completed and the Rector Reverend Pratt and his family are now occupying their new home. The rectory is a beautiful residence, and is easily the finest house in Mullewa." The Reverend Pratt was an active Pastor who worked hard at servicing the needs of the parishioners of Mullewa and the Murchison. In 1929, on one of his trips through the Murchison, he covered over 400 miles and visited numerous pastoral stations in the Murchison district to conduct services. In 1938, the Anglican Guild resolved that the Rectory could be let out at a low rental to a tenant of the Anglican faith.
