



ENROLMENT ELIGIBILITY CLAIM Owner or Co-Owner

FORM 2A Regulation 12A of the Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997

Under section 4.32(2) of the *Local Government Act 1995* (the Act), you may make a claim for eligibility as an owner using this form at any time. However, if you want to be on the roll for a particular election, you must give your claim form to the local government more than 57 days before the election date.

You should fill in this form if you want to vote at local government elections for that district and you:

- Own rateable property in a district or ward but are not on the residents roll in that district or ward; or
- Qualify under clause 12 of Schedule 9.3 of the Act based on ownership.

When you have completed this form, email it to your local government. You may also send it by post or other electronic means so long as it is capable of being printed in its entirety, including a signature. If you send it electronically, you should request confirmation of receipt.
